Increase in garbage cost

The council would like to inform you of a rate change effective in February. The current garbage rate, billed every other month, is \$33.60. This amount is no longer sufficient to cover the costs. The council voted unanimously to approve the increase to \$39.14.

Hall Rentals

The council also voted to make changes to rental fees, deposits, and terms when renting City Hall. The changes can be found on the cityofskyline.com website under Community/City Hall Rental Information. Costs for resident changed from \$60/day to \$75/day and non-residents from \$100/day to \$150/day. The will help fund necessary upkeep at the hall and cover cleaning costs.
