- Meeting called to order by Mayor at 6:45 pm
- Pledge of Allegiance performed by all in attendance
- Approve Agenda and Minutes- Michelle motioned to approve the March agenda and February minutes, Joanne seconded. Passed unanimously.

- Drainage Committee update** - Flooding mitigation committee minutes were shared with the council. Tentatively planning an open house meeting April 16th. Meeting March 26th to finalize the agenda for the meeting. The committee has recommended that the City pursue acquiring the tile/easement for the intermittent privately owned pieces of tile. This will need to be addressed with an attorney. The committee would like to have the city adopt a policy regarding water mitigation in Skyline. (i.e. no rain gutters in tiles) Nancy suggests that it could be just a Guideline if necessary as well. Nancy has researched that many other cities have this too. They are going to suggest that the council limits structures in the easements in the future.
